* You should note down the grade which you are PREDICTED to achieve (this may not be the same as your target grade and must be predicted by your class teacher)

Instructions for completion of Option Choices

1. Please select a subject you wish to study from each of the columns (**Do not choose the same subject twice!**). Pupils must choose 4 National Qualifications (N5/Higher) or 3 Advanced Highers. A Foundation Apprenticeship counts as two National Qualifications. Please note that if, in August, a pupil drops from 3 to 2 AH courses they will have to choose 2 additional National Qualifications to study. Pupils must select 1 Wider Achievement Bundle. The bundle should not be the same as the one studied in S5. One column should be left blank as a Private Study column. Two columns can be left blank for Private Study if you are taking 3 Advanced Highers.
2. Select the level at which you wish to study the subject. (Make sure that the level you wish to study is available in the column)
3. Take your form to the class teacher in your subject. They will then sign off your choice as appropriate for you. This must be done if you wish to continue with the subject at your chosen level.
4. If you are new to the subject and therefore have no class teacher, then take your form to be signed by the Faculty Head of the chosen subject.
5. Please note down on the form if there is any subject that you are unable to take due to the column structure. This does not guarantee a structure change but we will review options and accommodate where possible.
6. Principal Teachers Pupil Support will conduct options interviews from Monday 27th to Friday 31st January. Option sheet must be returned to school by **Friday 31st January** at the latest.
