

Free Bus Travel for 5-21 yr olds



From 31 January 2022, all 5-21 year olds resident in Scotland are eligible for Young Persons' Free Bus Travel, using a National Entitlement Card otherwise referred to as the Young Scot Card

ALL 5-21 yr olds who wish Free Bus Travel must apply for a [NEW YOUNG SCOT CARD!](#) Previously issued Young Scot NECs will NOT allow access to the scheme.



Your child needs a new National Entitlement Card (NEC)



Free Bus Travel for 5-21 yr olds



- 11-15 yrs - parents/carers must apply on child's behalf
- 16-21 yrs- can apply themselves, they must use their mygovscot myaccount
